**AMENDMENT TO THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

Amendment #4 is being proposed to the **FY 2009-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the State of Rhode Island**, as adopted by the State Planning Council on August 14, 2008.

The amendment has been requested by the RI Public Transit Authority (RIPTA) and the RI Department of Transportation (RIDOT) for the following purposes:

- Add new projects and reschedule projects to include available discretionary funding.
- Reprogram projects to take advantage of new eligible activities and adjust programmed projects to match available funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

The following TIP Programs will be affected:

- Pavement Management
- Enhancements
- Transit
- Bridge
- Traffic/Safety



The Rhode Island Public Transit Authority is requesting amendment to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). These changes, which are detailed below and included in Attachment A, reflect the Federal Transit Authority's (FTA) expansion of activities that are eligible for American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding, adjustments to other ARRA projects and the addition of an awarded Transit Investments for Greenhouse Gas and Energy Reduction (TIGGER) grant.

New TIP Funding Categories

- Transit Operations-Urban: The FTA has revised its list of eligible activities to include operation of transit services that retain current transit levels. RIPTA proposes to use \$1.0 million in FY10 to continue operation of its transit services.
- Management, Project Administration, will be funded in FY10 at \$.20 million for ARRA project management.
- Support Equipment, Replacement: The FTA has awarded RIPTA a \$345,000 discretionary TIGGER grant; this grant will fund energy efficient upgrades to the lighting in RIPTA facilities in FY10.

Support Equipment, Corridor Improvements: Improvements in transit corridors were originally included in Facilities – Upgrade/Expansion category at a funding level of \$0.97 million in FY09. In order to provide a more accurate description, this project has been moved to a new TIP category, Support Equipment/Supplies/Vehicles-Corridor Improvements. This project will include construction and installation of passenger amenities, such as shelters and signage, and traffic signalization along designated corridors. These investments will improve the efficiency of transit operations and passenger convenience on the designated corridors. Funding for corridor improvements has increased and is now programmed at \$1.74 million in FY10.

Changes in Existing TIP Funding Categories

---

In the Facilities – Admin/Maintenance, Upgrade/Expansion category, RIPTA has reduced the programmed funds to \$.84 million in FY09. The remaining funds are allocated to transit enhancements at Kennedy Plaza and security improvements at RIPTA facilities. RIPTA is moving the bus corridor improvements from this category to a new funding category, as outlined above.

Support Equipment/Supplies/Vehicle, Preventive Maintenance funding has been increased to \$1.13 million in FY10 in order to cover changes in the Kennedy Plaza repaving project and additional costs of the bus engine retrofits. Preventive maintenance funding will also be used to repair roofs and other structural elements of RIPTA facilities.

RIPTA has been working on implementing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) projects for several years; this year RIPTA received favorable bids for a previously advertised ITS project, resulting in significant cost savings. In addition, RIPTA has also identified available funding in existing grants to fund ITS projects. The cost savings realized from these factors have allowed us to complete the previously programmed ITS projects without the need to use the \$2.15 million in the FY09 TIP.

Funding in the Support Equipment/Supplies/Vehicles, Replacement category has been reduced by \$0.48 million. Equipment that was previously been programmed for ARRA funding will be funded with 5307 formula funds.

Fiscal constraint is maintained as this amendment reprograms existing ARRA funding and only increases funding in the TIP by a total of \$345,000, the amount of the TIGGER grant. Attachment B provides additional information on fiscal constraint. We request that these amendments be presented to the Transportation Advisory Committee and the State Planning Council for action. Thank you for your ongoing assistance in managing the Transportation Improvement Program

**Subject:** RIDOT Request for TIP Amendment

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) is requesting that the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) be amended to provide for the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding of eight (8) additional highway projects, and to make adjustments to the Enhancement Program approved by the Transportation Enhancement Advisory Committee.

#### ARRA Projects Added

Rhode Island is receiving \$137.1 million in ARRA funding for highway projects. When the TIP was amended in April 2009, fifty-four (54) projects were designated for ARRA highway funding. RIDOT has worked quickly to implement these projects, and to date funding has been authorized for all but two of the original 54 projects. Forty-two (42) of the projects are underway with awarded contracts. Due to a favorable bidding climate, the estimated cost to implement the fifty-four (54) original projects is \$12.4 million less than the ARRA funding provided. Of this \$12.4 million, \$9.4 million has been realized from projects for which bids have been opened, with an additional \$3 million expected from savings from projects yet to be bid. This \$12.4 million in savings would be reprogrammed in this proposed TIP amendment to allow RIDOT to meet the requirement that all ARRA projects be authorized for funding by March 2009. Fiscal Constraint is maintained since this amendment is merely a reprogramming of ARRA project savings. The ARRA project funding status is shown on Attachment A.

This amendment would designate four (4) projects currently included in the TIP for ARRA funding in FY 2010 in the following TIP programs: Pavement Management (3 projects) and Bridge (1 project). One Enhancement project, the Kingston Tower Relocation, currently in the TIP, would receive ARRA funds in FY 2010, in addition to the programmed TIP funds. Also, two new Pavement Management projects and one new drainage project would be added to the TIP for ARRA funding in FY 2010. The table in Appendix B provides information on the eight (8) projects to be included in the TIP for ARRA funding in FY 2010

### **Enhancement Program Changes**

In the implementation of the Enhancement Program, a need has arisen to change the TIP in the following manner:

- Add a new project, the Rochambeau Trail, Phase II, for future year implementation;
- At the request of the City of Cranston, replace the Pawtuxet River Canoe Portage project with the Cranston Street Enhancement Project for implementation in 2011; and
- Change the name of the Engineering, Archaeological and Program Support line item to Program Administration and Increase the Associated Costs

### **Rochambeau Trail, Phase II, \$256,500**

The Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary Route was designated a National Historic Trail in March of 2009. RIDOT is currently working with the Rhode Island Historic Preservation and Heritage Commission and the National Park Service on a planning phase to update and complete the trail as currently marked in Rhode Island. Once this planning phase is complete, an interpretive phase, including the provision of updated signage, interpretive panels, and brochures will proceed. The Transportation Enhancement Advisory Committee (TEAC) approved this Interpretive Phase back in April of 2006. Implementation is expected to occur in FY 2011.

### **Replace the Pawtuxet River Canoe Portage project with Cranston Street Enhancement Project**

The City of Cranston has requested that the Pawtuxet River Canoe Portage project be replaced in the Enhancement Program with the Cranston Street Enhancement Project. Prior to submitting this request to the Transportation Enhancement Advisory Committee (TEAC) for consideration, the City spent \$50,000 in City funds to identify enhancement and pedestrian safety measures for Cranston Street between Route 5 and Vinton Street. This area of Cranston Street provides access to a number of schools, and direct and indirect links to the Washington Secondary Bicycle Path and numerous City athletic fields. The study recommended a number of pedestrian enhancements, driver feedback signs, curb extensions (bump-outs) at various intersections and strategically located mid-block narrowing center islands. These studies were presented to RIDOT in the spring of 2009, and the TEAC approved this project change in August of 2009. This project is proposed for implementation in FY 2011

**Change the Engineering, Archaeological and Program Support Line Item to Program Administration and Increase the Associated Costs**

Managing the Enhancement Program requires expenditures on ancillary program support items such as construction materials testing and construction inspection through consulting services in addition to Engineering, Archaeological and Program Support. This amendment allows RIDOT to supplement staff where needed in order to continue to meet federal oversight requirements. The cost for Program Administration activities is estimated to be \$600,000 per year.

Attachment C lists the current Enhancement Program anticipated schedule reflecting the changes proposed in the amendment request. Note that there is no increase in funding for the Enhancement Program proposed in this amendment request so that the TIP's fiscal constraint is not affected.

Please bring this amendment request before the Transportation Advisory Committee and State Planning Council for action. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.
